Creating a safe environment for your Experience can help your attendees feel comfortable. You can use the following emergency preparedness plan—prepared by the Red Cross—to provide safety information to your participants in case of a natural disaster or any other kind of emergency that occurs during your activity.

Follow these 4 steps to create your Emergency Plan:

1. Identify

4. Prepare your kit

Prepare your Portable Disaster Supplies Kit and keep it with you. A well-equipped kit could help you face any kind of disaster. Use the following checklist as a guide to collect the items. Check the expiration date of the products every six months.

- HYGIENE ITEMS (HAND SANITIZER, TOILET PAPER, TOOTHBRUSHES, TOOTHPASTE, MOIST TOWELETTES)
- BATTERY POWERED OR HAND-CRANK RADIO
- BATTERIES
- CASH
